The fifth grade students have been learning about the Earth's spheres (geosphere, hydrosphere, biosphere, atmosphere) and how they interact. As community contributors, we partnered with Hawai'i Wildlife Fund to do our small part to clean up Kamilo Beach.

In total, the 29 of us (19 keiki) removed 945 lbs of debris including 20 lbs of derelict fishing line and net bundles along this special stretch of coastline. HWF has removed over 259 tons of marine debris off the shores of Hawai'i Island since 2003 - thanks to volunteers and supporters like us!!
